English Chess Federation Membership

Anyone wishing to play rated standard (or rapid) play chess in England is able to play up to 3 games (7 rapid) without charge. Blitz games are not counted.

Further games result in the ECF automatically assigning you bronze membership, which is recharged to West Nottingham Chess Club. There are 2 categories of membership:

Category	Entitled to play in:
Bronze	League and County Chess; rated internal club games
Gold	All ECF and FIDE-rated tournaments

Anyone playing in a West Nottingham team is required to join the ECF after they have played in 3 matches. Existing members should have been contacted by the ECF to renew their membership. You can renew an existing membership or apply for new membership by going on the ECF website: www.englishchess.org.uk/ecf-membership-rates-and-joining-details/

If a junior (under 18) or a student in full-time education, and have not previously been an ECF member, you can apply for free Gold membership for one year. To do so join online for membership as usual, then select 'Free Junior Gold' or 'Free Student Gold'.
