English Chess Federation Membership

Anyone wishing to play rated chess in England is able to play up to 3 games standardplay (7 rapid) without charge. Blitz games are not counted. After this, games played result in the ECF automatically assigning you Bronze membership, which is recharged to West Nottingham Chess Club. There are 2 categories of membership:

Category	Entitled to play in:
Bronze	League and County Chess; internal club competitions.
Gold	All individual rated events

Anyone playing in a West Nottingham league team is required to join the ECF after they have played in 3 matches standardplay or 7 games of rapidplay. Existing members should have been contacted by the ECF to renew their membership.

If a **junior** (under 18) or a **student in full-time education**, and have not previously been an ECF member, you can apply for free Gold membership for one year. To do so join online for membership as usual, then select 'Free Junior Gold' or 'Free Student Gold'.
